ORIGINATING FROM THE SOUTH-WEST REGION OF FRANCE, THE SAUVIGNON BLANC HAS COME A LONG WAY SINCE IT WAS FIRST CHRISTENED 'PETIT SAUVIGNON' IN THE GIRONDE AREA DURING THE 17TH CENTURY. THE WHITE VARIETAL WINE ROSE IN STATURE IN THE 1960s WHEN THE WINE-DRINKING ELITE OF FRANCE THOUGHT WELL OF THE WINES FROM POUILLY FUMÉ AND SANCERRE.
